St Wilfrid's Hospice, Chichester | Bungee Jump experience Terms & Conditions

The below terms and conditions have been written to ensure that St Wilfrid's Hospice can support its fundraisers in the best possible way, whilst raising as much as possible to fund its work. To secure a place in the Bungee Jump Challenge event:

- To secure a place and Bungee at Brighton Marina we require you to agree to the terms and conditions, register online and pay a deposit.
- To secure a place we require a registration fee of £30 (non-refundable/non-transferable) which must be paid at the point of registration. In addition, we ask that you pledge to raise a minimum of £250 (excluding registration fee and gift aid) in sponsorship money for St Wilfrid's Hospice. All funds raised through the Challenge must be made payable to St Wilfrid's Hospice. The objective is to raise as much sponsorship as possible before and immediately after the event.

Fundraising:

- You understand that each charity place costs the Hospice £45 plus VAT. Your £45 registration fee plus your minimum sponsorship will go towards covering the costs. We ask that you raise a minimum of £250 to cover the cost of the place and to raise additional funds for St Wilfrid's.
- As a fundraising event this is a great opportunity for St Wilfrid's Hospice to promote our involvement on social media and in other advertising media. By applying for a place you are agreeing that you are happy for us to use your story, photos and videos to promote the Hospice.
- You understand that if you cancel your place less than 4 weeks before the date you are booked on that you will agree to cover the cost of your place by donating £15 plus VAT (inclusive of your £30 registration) to St Wilfrid's Hospice.

Your details and Data Protection:

- We will store your personal details, as provided on your registration, securely on our database. Please be aware that we will need to contact you with regards to this event however, outside of this correspondence, we would like to keep you informed about our work with terminally-ill people. You can choose to hear from us in a variety of ways or opt-out of further correspondence, by emailing us your preferences at: fundraising@stwh.co.uk

Privacy & Sharing of Information:

- Limited personal details will be shared with our Bungee partner UKBC, this is for the event only and will not be used for marketing purposes.



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Requirements to abseil as set out by the event organiser UK Bungee Club

1. Each Bungee Jumper must be:

- 14 years of age or over.
- 14 and 15 Year olds require a parent or guardians permission and signature
- Over 50's are required to have a doctors certificate to comply with our insurance regulations
- If you do not meet both of the above criteria you will not be allowed to Bungee.
- Glasses and hard contact lenses cannot be worn
- If wearing boots please be prepared to remove them
- Maximum weight limit for a solo jumper is 120kg (18.9 stone)
- Waist harnesses fit waist size of 40cm (15.7 inches) to 125cm (49.2 inches)
- The bungee is not suitable for anyone who is pregnant.

2. Alcohol and substances:

- Abseilers must not be under the influence of alcohol or legal or illegal substances which would make it unsafe for them to participate in the Bungee or to understand the instructions given by the Bungee contractors.
- You will not be allowed to participate if we suspect you are under the influence of alcohol, legal or illegal substances which we believe would make it unsafe for you to Bungee. No refunds will be given in this case.

3. Physical requirements:

If you are not in good health you should **NOT** jump. If you have any of the following conditions you should seek medical advice before jumping.

- High Blood Pressure
- Heart Condition
- Suffer from Dizziness or Epilepsy
- Damage to neck, back, spinal column, legs or eyes
- Asthma
- Pregnancy
- Alcohol – If you appear intoxicated you cannot jump
- Medication - please inform us if you are taking any form of medication.

If you suffer from any of the above but have been given a doctors certificate, you will be requested to sign a non standard waiver.

4. Arrival time:

- The time of your experience is a guide time only, there is no guarantee that you will complete your experience at the exact time given on your booking confirmation however we try to stick to these times as closely as possible.

5. The weather:

- Nearly all of our experiences are weather dependent. Please be aware that the weather can be unpredictable and events do have to be cancelled because of this, high winds and thunderstorms are our main concerns. Cancelling an event can be a huge inconvenience for both participants and us here at the UK Bungee Club, however the safety of our jumpers and crew is paramount and we would appreciate your understanding with this. If bad weather affects a booking it will be rescheduled by the UK Bungee Club at no extra charge to you for a later date. No refunds will be given .
